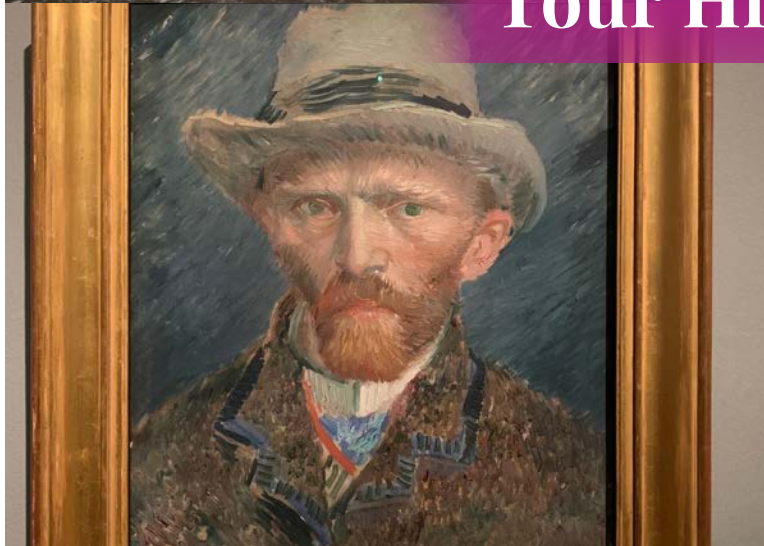

Explore the medieval charm of Bruges, the “Venice of the North”, on a relaxing scenic canal cruise.

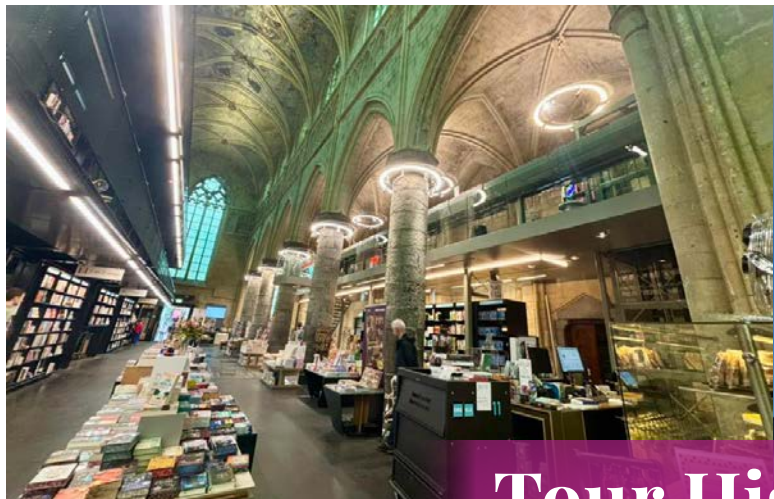


Galeries Royales Saint-Hubert

4 Amsterdam - Keukenhof Gardens (admission + 3.5-hr visit) - Van Gogh Museum (admission incl.) - Diamond Showroom - Glass-Roof Canal Cruise (ticket incl.)

[Diamond Showroom] Since the 17th century, Amsterdam has been known as the diamond capital of the world. Witness the exquisite craftsmanship of polishing raw diamonds into dazzling masterpieces.

[Glass-Roof Canal Cruise] Amsterdam's canal network stretches over 100 km, formed mainly by the Herengracht, Prinsengracht, and Keizersgracht canals. Dug during the Dutch Golden Age in the 17th century, this system stands as a testament to successful urban planning.

5 Amsterdam - Rotterdam - Markthal - Cube Houses - Maastricht (Historic City on the Dutch-Belgian Border) - Caves of Mount St. Pieter (optional)

[Markthal] An iconic modern landmark of Rotterdam featuring a massive arched market hall with international delicacies, local specialties, and handmade desserts.

[Cube Houses] A creative architectural masterpiece by Piet Blom - houses built at a 45-degree tilt, admired for their unique and imaginative design.

[Caves of Mount St. Pieter] A vast underground maze formed from centuries of limestone mining, with over 20,000 tunnels once used as wartime shelters and secret military bases. Ancient wall carvings and murals tell fascinating stories from the past.

6 Masstricht - Bookstore Dominicanen (admission incl.) - Leuven Old Town - Brussels, Belgium - Galeries Royales Saint Hubert - Grand Place - Manneken Pis

[Bookstore Dominicanen] Hailed as one of the world's most beautiful bookstores, this 13th-century Gothic church - once a Dominican monastery - has been transformed into a sanctuary where books and art harmoniously meet.

[Grand Place] A UNESCO World Heritage site, described by Victor Hugo as "the most beautiful square in Europe," surrounded by guildhalls adorned with golden sculptures.

7 Brussels - 🚢 "Venice of the North" Bruges (Canal Cruise incl.) - Market Square - Stadhuis - Belfy of Bruges - Basilica of the Holy Blood - Antwerp (optional) - Brussels

[Market Square] A must-visit UNESCO site surrounded by Gothic and Baroque architecture, taking you back to the splendor of medieval Europe.

[Belfry] An 83-meter-tall medieval tower offering panoramic views of Bruges' intricate canal network.

[Basilica of the Holy Blood] Built in the 12th century, this sacred site is renowned for housing a relic said to contain the Holy Blood of Jesus Christ, drawing countless pilgrims from around the world.

[Antwerp] A city blending history, art, and modernity - stroll through its old town streets, savor Belgian beer, and admire its architectural beauty and cultural richness.
