## 3 Akashi Kaikyō Bridge – Awaji Island Observatory – Naruto Whirlpools (“Uzu no Michi” walkway admission incl.)

[Akashi Kaikyō Bridge] Spanning 3,911 meters between Honshu and Shikoku, it’s the world’s longest suspension bridge and a marvel of Japanese engineering.

[Awaji Island Observatory] Enjoy sweeping views of the Akashi Strait and northern Awaji Island - one of the best vantage points to admire the bridge and surrounding seascape.

[Naruto Whirlpools] Experience powerful tidal vortices up to 20 meters wide at the Naruto Strait. The 45m-high glass walkway “Uzu no Michi” offers an exhilarating close-up of this natural spectacle.

## 4 Awa Odori Kaikan (admission incl.) – Tokushima Indigo Dyeing Experience (admission incl.) – Iya Kazurabashi Vine Bridge (admission incl.)

[Awa Odori Kaikan] Experience Japan’s iconic Awa Dance, over 400 years old. Explore exhibits on its history, costumes, and music - and try dancing yourself.

[Tokushima Indigo Dyeing] Learn the 400-year tradition of Tokushima indigo dyeing, using fermented natural plants. Try dyeing cloth or handkerchiefs and take home your own creation.

[Iya Kazurabashi Vine Bridge] Cross the historic vine bridge spanning Iya Gorge, originally woven by the Heike clan. Swaying above rushing waters, it’s a thrilling hidden gem of Shikoku.

## 5 Oboke Gorge – Koboke Gorge – Kōchi Castle (admission incl.) – Katsurahama Beach – Hirome Market

**[Oboke Gorge]** Carved by the Yoshino River, with towering rocks and clear rapids, known as “Shikoku’s natural sculpture gallery.”

**[Koboke Gorge]** Dramatic narrow channels, swift currents, and sheer cliffs showcase Shikoku’s rugged landscapes.

**[Kōchi Castle]** One of Japan’s few original wooden castles, offering panoramic views of the city from its Edo-period keep.

**[Katsurahama Beach]** White sands, crashing waves, and expansive Pacific vistas create a majestic coastal scene.

**[Hirome Market]** Lively market with eateries and stalls, featuring local specialties like straw-seared bonito and fresh seafood.

## 6 Kotohira-gū Shrine & Omotesandō – Kotohiki Park – Zenigata Sand Sculpture Observatory – Chichibugahama Beach

**[Kotohira-gū Shrine & Omotesandō]** Climb to the “Guardian of the Sea” shrine for mountain and ocean views, then explore Omotesandō street’s shops and traditional sweets.

**[Kotohiki Park]** Pine groves and ocean vistas, featuring the 122m Zenigata Sand Sculpture, a symbol of wealth and good fortune.

**[Zenigata Sand Sculpture Observatory]** Panoramic views of the giant coin and Seto Inland Sea; legend says it brings good luck.

**[Chichibugahama Beach]** Famous for mirror-like reflections at low tide, enhanced by romantic sunset glow.

## 7 Takamatsu (Ferry ticket incl.) → Shodoshima – Angel Road – Michi-no-Eki Roadside Station – Olive Park – Kankakei Ropeway (ticket incl.) – Soy Sauce Museum (admission incl.) (Ferry ticket incl.) Okayama

**[Angel Road]** A romantic sandbar visible at low tide, linking Shodoshima to nearby islets—said to bless couples who walk it hand in hand.

**[Michi-no-Eki Roadside Station]** A local stop featuring fresh produce, olive products, and handmade crafts.

**[Olive Park]** One of Japan’s earliest olive regions, with 30,000 olive trees, white windmills, and Mediterranean-style scenery.

**[Kankakei Ropeway]** A scenic cable ride over Kankakei Gorge, offering sweeping views of dramatic cliffs and the Seto Inland Sea.

**[Soy Sauce Museum]** Showcasing Shodoshima’s century-old soy sauce brewing tradition, historic wooden barrels, and the brewing process.

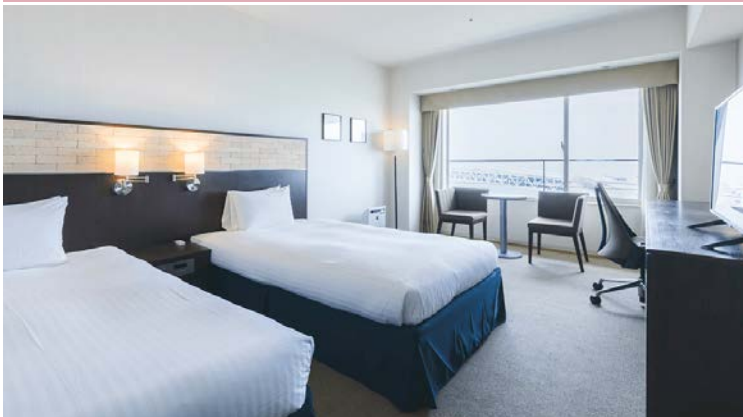
## 8 Okayama Kōrakuen Garden (admission incl.) – Kurashiki Bikan Historical Quarter – Himeji Castle (admission incl.)

**[Okayama Kōrakuen Garden]** One of Japan's top three gardens, created in the Edo period, renowned for its spacious landscape, seasonal beauty, and Michelin Green Guide three-star rating.

**[Kurashiki Bikan Historical Quarter]** The Quarter well preserves traditional Edo- to Meiji-era townhouses and white-walled warehouses. Along the winding canal, the reflections of historic buildings and willow trees create a timeless, picturesque scene.



**[Himeji Castle]** Known as the “White Heron Castle” for its elegant white exterior, is one of Japan's most iconic castles and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Its main keep, gates, and stone walls remain intact, showcasing the strategic design and aesthetic beauty of the feudal era.
