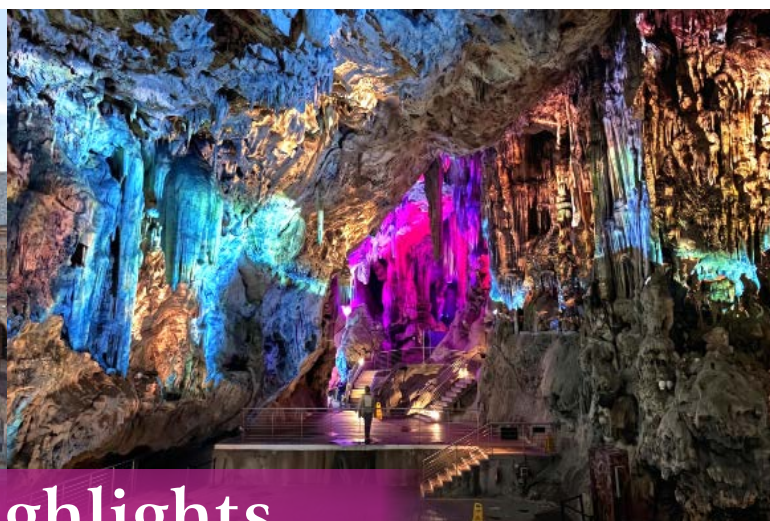

[\[Discovery Monument\]](#) A Tagus River landmark shaped like a ship's prow, honouring Portugal's explorers.

[\[Belém Tower\]](#) A 16th-century UNESCO landmark and Manueine symbol of Portugal's seafaring spirit.

[\[Jerónimos Monastery\]](#) UNESCO masterpiece of Manueine architecture, famed for intricate stonework.

[\[Liberty Avenue\]](#) Elegant Lisbon boulevard lined with luxury boutiques, fine hotels and graceful architecture.

[\[Óbidos\]](#) One of Portugal's best-preserved medieval towns, with flower-filled lanes and whitewashed houses.

[\[Cape of the Rock\]](#) Continental Europe's westernmost point, with sweeping Atlantic views from 140-metre cliffs.

[\[Sintra\]](#) A romantic UNESCO-listed hill town of royal palaces and elegant villas.

[\[Sintra National Palace\]](#) Portugal's best-preserved medieval royal palace, famed for twin white chimneys and diverse architectural styles.

[\[Sintra Old Town\]](#) Stroll cobblestone streets lined with traditional shops, boutiques and cafés.

[\[St. Michael's Cave\]](#) Enter Gibraltar's Rock to admire spectacular stalactites and stalagmites within a natural cavern transformed into a unique performance space.

[\[The Ape's Den\]](#) Meet Gibraltar's free-roaming Barbary macaques, Europe's best-known wild primates and a distinctive natural icon.

[\[Europa Point\]](#) Gibraltar's southern tip, where the Mediterranean, Strait of Gibraltar and Atlantic converge, with views of Africa on clear days.

[Mosque-Cathedral of Córdoba] A world-class architectural treasure famed for its iconic red-and-white arches, uniting Islamic and Christian heritage.

[Calleja de las Flores] A charming Jewish Quarter lane, with colourful flowerpots lining whitewashed walls and framing the cathedral bell tower.

[Toledo Cathedral] One of Spain's finest Gothic cathedrals, featuring ornate altarpieces, woodcarving and sacred art.

[Royal Palace of Madrid] Spain's grand royal palace, featuring Neoclassical architecture and lavish state rooms.

[Plaza Mayor] Historic square framed by red façades and elegant arcades.

[Puerta del Sol] Madrid's central square, home to Kilometre Zero and the Bear and Strawberry Tree statue.

[Plaza de Colón] Square honouring Christopher Columbus, marked by a monumental memorial.

[Roman Aqueduct] UNESCO-listed aqueduct over 2,000 years old, with 167 granite arches built without mortar.

[Alcázar of Segovia] Medieval UNESCO-listed castle, once a fortress and later a royal residence.
